CSR PROJECTS APPROVED BY THE BOARD FOR FY 2022-23

As per Section 135 of the Companies Act 2013, the Company has to spend, in every financial year, at least 2% of the average net profits of the Company made during the three immediately preceding financial years, in pursuance of its CSR Policy. 2% of the average net profit of the Company during the immediately preceding three years was Rs.51,80,659 as per the provisions of the Companies Act 2013. Thus, the total amount available for CSR expenditure during FY 2022-23 is Rs.51,80,659.

The CSR Committee has recommended and the Board at its meeting held on 1.08.2022 has approved the CSR project of the Company for the FY 2022-23 as tabled below;
