

Couple died coming under debris of 'Kuccha' DU

Due to collapse of wall and rooftop made of 'murrum', plastic

Balod, Jun 30: A couple living in 'Kuccha' dwelling unit (DU) in Gram Sirpur under Devari thana died coming under debris of the DU when it collapsed. Due to incessant rains for last few days, the wall and roof of the house collapsed.

It was on the intervening night of Wednesday that both Santram Yadav, (55) and his wife Kunti Bai (50), were sleeping in their house and during rains the roof and wall collapsed all of sudden and both died on the spot. With heavy rains slashing the whole night, nobody came to know about it.

It is notable here that roof of the DU in which the couple were living was with made from Plastic and 'murrum' and since it was raining continuously,



the walls became wet and collapsed, bringing down the rooftop as well. The most surprising thing here is that nobody heard the noise from falling of the wall.

Both the couple remained inside the debris whole night and in the morning the villagers came to know about it. Just at a short distance, the son sleeping in the

'pucca' house was also not aware of the same. The final rites of both were performed the next day at Lohara Community Health Centre.

PM Aawas constructed two yrs back

As per information in this regard, the DU of the couple was constructed two years back and in the 'pucca' DU their son Deepak Yadav and others

used to live, whereas the old couple used to live in their old 'kuccha' house. In the morning when Jitendra Sen and other neighbours knocked at the door, nobody responded and then they came to know that both mother and father of Deepak have died.

Compensation of Rs 4 lakh made

On getting information about the incident, both the police and revenue department team reached the site and started the procedure of providing due compensation. SDM Pratima Thakre informed that immediately after this incident, the case was prepared and a compensation case of Rs 4 lakh each to the victim of house collapse was made and sent and hopefully the family would get the compensation soon.
